



Set the children a tricky challenge, e.g build a tower from cards, pick frozen peas out of a bowl using only tweezers (find a challenge that's genuinely hard to complete!)  - How did you find that challenge?  - How did it make you feel?  - What sorts of tricky things do we do every day?  - How do you sort these out?  Explain to the children that sometimes we come across things that are hard, but that we shouldn't give up straight away. We should keep on trying and think about a different way to solve the problem if our current method isn't working.
